The DIP (District Improvement Plan) is revised annually. Our district missed AYP (Adequate Yearly Progress) in Special Education Reading & Math. The DIP has to be revised to address how we are addressing needs in Reading & Math. The district will continue PLC (Professional Learning Community) training and RtI (Response to Intervention) training. These trainings teach us how to share ideas between staff and classrooms. We are also working on common assessments and benchmarks. The district is promoting college readiness beginning at the elementary level. High school principals take students to visit colleges.

2. Program Evaluations

Yearly evaluations have to be prepared for State Compensatory Education, High School Allotment, Title I, and Title II programs. These are done by looking at the Comprehensive Needs Assessment and connecting it to the DIP. The evaluations need to reflect how funds were spent to improve needs. These evaluations will be brought to the next Site-Based meeting for your review and approval.

3. Budget Cuts in Federal & State Programs

Budget amounts for federal programs were received in June. Title II was cut by 29%. In August, we received the report that the district did not meet AYP. Due to this fact, 10% of the Title I budget had to be reserved for professional development. We plan to be conservative when planning budgets in the future due to the economic conditions, and the fact that we have to reserve the 10% again next year from the Title I budget.
